Good Evening Members,

A communication from the City of London Employer was sent today to all members who are on a Designated Emergency Leave (DEL).

As outlined in the memorandum, the day following the end of the Provincial Emergency Order, all staff on DEL will be returned to the workplace. **The return date for staff off on DEL is Monday July 27, 2020.**

The Union and the Employer recognizes this may have an impact on people's eligibility for their July CERB entitlement. We were both hopeful that the Provincial order would take us to the forecasted return date of Aug 4, 2020 but as a result of Doug Ford's announcement to end the Emergency order the DEL staffs return to work date was moved to Monday, July 27, 2020.

The employer has confirmed that those returning from DEL will be paid on July 30, 2020 for 1 week. Should you have questions about how this income may impact your CERB benefit for July, you should direct those questions to the CERB program.
